PART B – Supporting Documentation

You have the opportunity to 'walk the judges through' your project so they can experience it in the same way that a visitor might. For example, in the case of a display or exhibition, you could provide a floor plan and legible images of graphic panels in the order they would be experienced by a visitor; for 'live' interpretive projects you could provide a script and/or short You Tube clip of a typical guided tour. This material should be clearly identified with your Project Title and submitted electronically with your Project Submission.

Supporting material provided such as photographs and videos may be utilised to showcase your submission at the IA National Awards for Excellence presentation.

Please do not upload large video or audio files. Provide links to the resources so that judges can access these as desired.
